26 June-27 July

The Flintham Museum looks at rural life through the eyes of a village shopkeeper. The exhibition celebrates two decades since volunteers turned muck and muddle into a museum and began using their collection in unexpected ways.

MY TOWN IN OILS

31 July-31 Aug

This is the first exhibition of local artist Derek 'FRO' Froggatt. It features some lovely local scenes in oils of areas in Newark that have captured his imagination. Most works will be for sale.

ART TO ENJOY GROUP

4 Sept-5 Oct

Tutored by Ali McDonald, this exhibition is a celebration of ART which strives to find new methods of depicting objects, figures, landscapes, nature, scenes from everyday life and thoughts. This is a rare sale of unique work.

DOWN THE TRENT TO THE SEA

The River Trent is Nottinghamshire's water highway to the sea and beyond. Navigated from earliest times, retired ship captain Peter Adams illustrates in pen and wash drawing and watercolour paintings, the Trent's use for commerce and leisure in more recent times. Framed works are for sale.

WILLIAM J. CAPARNE (1855-1940)

6 Nov-14 Dec

The works on display are from a Private Collection of a long-time local collector of Caparne's art. Caparne was a Newark born artist who moved to Guernsey. He worked mainly in watercolour and pastels inspired by flowers and local landscapes.
